## Le Marais

## Quartier Latin

It is also where students revolted in May 1968 against Charles de Gaulle at the Sorbonne University and where is situated the famous Pantheon you can visit with us in another tour.

## Saint-Germain des Prés

## Historical centre

## The Covered passageways

## Père Lachaise Cemetery

This tour celebrates life and is conducive to mediation through amazing anecdotes.



## Museums & Monuments Tours



### Napoleon's tomb

Tuesday 1 pm – Thursday 1 pm  
Friday 10 am – Sunday 1 pm

"I wish my ashes to repose on the banks of the Seine, in the midst of the French people I have loved so well!"... Napoleon I rests since 1840 thanks to king Louis-Philippe I in the heart of the beautiful Dome Church where your guide will tell the legend of the man who upset so many kings in Europe and who still influences the French Republic nowadays. Your entrance ticket gives access on your own the Invalides' Army museum.

### Opera House

Monday 3:30 pm – Thursday 10 am

Charles Garnier's architectural genius, along with the legends of the Phantom, and the lifestyle of the 19th century's high society are the ingredients of this remarkable visit. Your guide will make alive the ambitious project of emperor Napoleon III for a temple of music and art for which the show was not only on stage but in the audience!  
NB: the auditorium is sometimes closed for rehearsals.

### Pantheon

Tuesday 10 am – Sunday 3:30 pm

"To great Men, an appreciative Nation". Since the French Revolution, this former church is host to some of the greatest names who have contributed, through their writings and actions, to France's greatness or international influence: from Voltaire, Rousseau and Victor Hugo to Marie Curie, Jean Moulin and more recently Simone & Antoine Veil.  
From April to October, after the tour, access to the top of the monument to embrace the astonishing view of Paris from St Geneviève Hill.

### Sainte-Chapelle

Monday 1 pm – Wednesday 1 pm

Built in only 6 years in 1248 as a jewel case to protect the crown of thorns of Christ brought back by King St Louis of the Crusades, this jewel of Gothic art was attached to the royal palace of the time. Your guide will explain how its audacious design and the magnificence of the religious stained-glass windows contributed to the political legitimacy of the king's power. On the very same day, your ticket gives you priority access to the Conciergerie, Marie-Antoinette's last prison...

Museums & Monuments Tours (up to 6 people - All Year long)

### The Two Louvre

Monday 10 am – Wednesday 3:30 pm

Visiting the largest museum of the world could take you an entire week! Within two hours, discover the 800 year history of the royal castle while enjoying the most famous paintings and sculptures without getting lost! Meet your guide at the statue outside the Pyramid entrance to enter the museum without queuing during hours. After the tour, stay any longer!

### Orsay Museum

This former railway station transformed into a museum in 1986 gathers masterpieces from the various artistic movements between 1848 to 1914 including a magnificent impressionist collection and some of the major works by Auguste Rodin. You will also discover a wonderful collection of Art Nouveau furniture. After the tour, stay any longer to explore the place by yourself!

### Catacombes

Tuesday 3:30 pm – Saturday 3:30 pm

"Stop, this is the empire of death" is the sentence welcoming you when going down the Catacombes, a manner to think on the fragility of human life during the tour. The remains of six million Parisians are buried in these former quarries from where the stones were extracted for so many buildings during centuries. The incredible story of this place is also a way to review the last 200 years of Paris history.  
NB: No elevator to go down. Bring a sweater with you as Hades kingdom is a bit chilly.
